

Exercise 2

Exercise 2 is a guitar exercise in the key of A major (indicated by three sharps: F#, C#, G#) and 4/4 time. It consists of 12 measures, divided into three systems of four measures each. The notation includes a treble clef, a key signature of three sharps, and a 4/4 time signature. The guitar TAB is written below the staff, and chord diagrams are placed above the staff. The first system (measures 1-4) features A7, D7, A7, and A7 chords. The second system (measures 5-8) features D7, D7, A7, and A7 chords.
